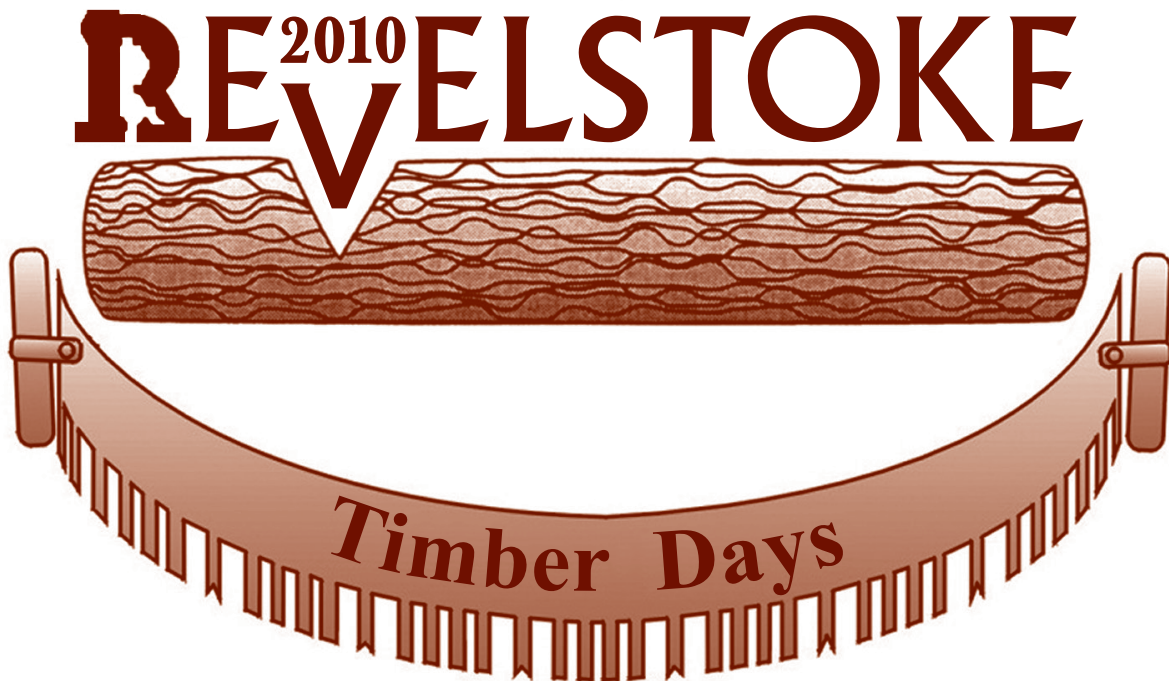


Celebrate Revelstoke's Logging Heritage... **Timber Days - August 14, 2010**

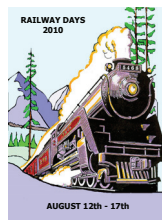
